

Mesquite Parks & Trails

The Mesquite Community enjoys the benefits of an extensive parks and trails network, which connects neighborhoods with parks and other city destinations. The City has approximately 100 acres of existing developed parks and 718 acres of future (proposed) parks. The trail system was designed to provide connectivity between open spaces. Currently, Mesquite contains 53 miles of built trails and 87 miles of proposed multi-use trails.

The graphic below identifies park activities, facilities and indicates if the park may be reserved. The circled numbers refer to the numbered parks on all graphics, including the main map on the reverse side. The Mesquite Sports and Event Complex (SEC) (see reverse side) is a 670 acre facility that integrates athletics with the natural environment. The SEC will consist of nearly 125 acres of accessible natural areas. Phase One of the SEC is complete and includes a shared soccer and field sports facility, which may be reserved. The Roadrunner Trail (lower right graphic) is four miles long and provides an off-street loop around downtown Mesquite. This trail utilizes the natural corridors of the washes and Virgin River to connect several destinations including eight city parks (numbered and highlighted in green), the Recreation Center, Library, Hughes Middle School, Virgin Valley Elementary School and the Virgin River, which is the most diverse ecosystem in the Mohave Desert.





Roadrunner Trail - Downtown Mesquite




Mesquite Parks & Trails
